

Opportunities for Undergraduates in Mathematics

Conferences

ASPiRE (Advancing Student Participation in Research Experiences) –

- An annual conference held at Florida Gulf Coast University each February to “educate students about what it means to do mathematics research and inform them of research opportunities”

GROW Conference – <https://www.imsi.institute/grow/>

- A conference “intended to provide support and encouragement to undergraduate students considering going to graduate school in the mathematical sciences and to help build a profession in which gender identity is not a barrier to participation”

Joint Mathematics Meeting (JMM) – <https://jointmathematicsmeetings.org/jmm>

- This is a national conference organized by the American Mathematical Society (AMS), and is the largest mathematics conference worldwide; it is usually held in early January with rotating locations
- There are many opportunities for students to present work:
 - AMS Special Session on Research in Mathematics by Undergraduates and Students in Post-Baccalaureate Programs (20-minute talks)
 - Pi Mu Epsilon (PME) Contributed Paper Sessions (10-minute talks)
 - AMS-PME Student Poster Session
- There are also travel grants for undergraduates
- *Deadlines to submit talks and apply for funding are often quite early, around August-September, so be sure to look out for these!*

MAA MathFest – <https://maa.org/event/mathfest/>

- This is the annual meeting of the Mathematical Association of America (MAA), usually held in late summer; probably the second largest annual mathematics conference in the United States after the JMM
- There is an undergraduate student poster session and a travel grant for students from historically underrepresented groups in mathematics who are presenting research
- *Deadlines to submit talks and apply for funding are often quite early, so be sure to look out for these!*

MAKO Undergraduate Mathematics Research Conference –

- Held annually for students in Missouri, Arkansas, Kansas, and Oklahoma

- A three-day conference held by the National Association of Mathematicians (NAM), typically in the fall, geared towards undergraduates attending Historically Black Colleges and Universities; location rotates each year

- Annual conference held at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln, usually in early spring, which “provides role models, insider knowledge, opportunities to present undergraduate research, and a growing community of peers interested in issues related to creating a supportive environment for women in mathematics”

- An annual virtual resource fair for students, by students
